## AN ACT

- 1 Designating the bridge on Stoughstown Road over Interstate 81 in
- 2 Cumberland County (bridge number 21-3007-0020-0865) as the
- 3 Private Raymond Lafayette Naugle Memorial Bridge.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Private Raymond Lafayette Naugle Memorial Bridge.
- 7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (1) Private Raymond Lafayette Naugle, a native of Walnut
- Bottom, enlisted in the United States Army on July 17, 1917.
- 11 (2) While serving with G Company, 2nd Battalion, 112th
- 12 Infantry Regiment, 28th Infantry Division, Private Naugle was
- 13 killed in action on November 8, 1918, in France.
- 14 (3) Private Naugle was awarded the World War I Victory
- 15 Medal.
- 16 (b) Designation. -- The bridge on Stoughstown Road in
- 17 Cumberland County over Interstate 81 (bridge number 21-3007-
- 18 0020-0865) is designated the Private Raymond Lafayette Naugle
- 19 Memorial Bridge.

- 1 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 2 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 3 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 4 Section 2. Effective date.
- 5 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
