INTRODUCED AS NONCONTROVERSIAL RESOLUTION UNDER RULE 35, FEBRUARY 28, 2017

A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of March 2017 as "Brain Injury Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Brain injury refers to the death or injury of brain
- 4 cells and the disruption of neural pathways resulting in changes
- 5 in the way a person thinks, feels and acts; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Acquired brain injury (ABI) is an injury to the
- 7 brain secondary to trauma, stroke, aneurysms, postsurgical
- 8 complications or certain acquired disease processes; and
- 9 WHEREAS, It is estimated that more than 3.5 million children
- 10 and adults sustain an ABI each year; and
- 11 WHEREAS, More than 12 million Americans live with ABI,
- 12 including stroke; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Traumatic brain injury (TBI), a subset of ABI, is an
- 14 insult to the brain caused by a direct blow to the head, the
- 15 head hitting an object or the head being shaken violently; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Approximately 2.5 million children and adults
- 2 sustain TBIs in the United States each year; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Each year, 2.2 million people are treated in
- 4 emergency departments for TBIs, and 280,000 individuals are
- 5 hospitalized for TBIs; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- 7 provides that the estimated economic cost of TBI in 2010,
- 8 including direct and indirect medical costs, was approximately
- 9 \$76.5 billion; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The CDC shares that TBI is a major cause of death
- 11 and disability in the United States, contributing to
- 12 approximately 30% of all injury deaths; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Approximately 5.3 million Americans live with TBI-
- 14 related disabilities; and
- WHEREAS, Every day, 137 individuals in the United States die
- 16 from TBI-related injuries, and each year 50,000 individuals in
- 17 the United States die from TBI; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The Brain Injury Association of Pennsylvania reports
- 19 the following statistics relating to brain injuries in
- 20 Pennsylvania:
- 21 (1) 245,621 individuals are living with brain injury.
- 22 (2) 2,223 individuals die from brain injuries each year.
- 23 (3) 10,463 individuals are hospitalized each year after
- 24 a brain injury.
- 25 (4) 49,505 individuals are seen in the emergency room
- following a brain injury each year.
- 27 (5) 25,975 children suffer brain injuries each year.
- 28 (6) 8,612 individuals sustain long-term or lifelong
- 29 disabilities from brain injury each year;
- 30 and

- 1 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has a number of leading research
- 2 centers for brain injury, including the Penn Center for Brain
- 3 Injury and Repair at the University of Pennsylvania, the Moss
- 4 Rehabilitation Research Institute, the Brain Trauma Research
- 5 Center at the University of Pittsburgh and the Center for Injury
- 6 Research and Prevention at the Children's Hospital of
- 7 Philadelphia; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Other organizations in this Commonwealth with a
- 9 strong focus on brain injury include the Brain Injury
- 10 Association of Pennsylvania, the Acquired Brain Injury Network
- 11 of Pennsylvania, the Pennsylvania Brain Injury Coalition,
- 12 Disability Rights Pennsylvania and the Rehabilitation and
- 13 Community Providers Association; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The Traumatic Brain Injury Advisory Board within the
- 15 Department of Health is also committed to expanding public
- 16 knowledge regarding TBI as well as increasing coordination and
- 17 integration within existing service delivery systems; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Additional programs within this Commonwealth that
- 19 administer specialized brain injury rehabilitation and community
- 20 support include the Head Injury Program and the CommCare Waiver;
- 21 and
- 22 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's BrainSTEPS Program, currently funded
- 23 by the Department of Health and the Department of Education,
- 24 provides assistance to students who have sustained an ABI and
- 25 provides consultation through the students' school districts
- 26 until graduation; and
- 27 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives notes the importance of
- 28 raising awareness about the prevention and treatment of brain
- 29 injuries and facilitating access to treatment and services;
- 30 therefore be it

- 1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 2 month of March 2017 as "Brain Injury Awareness Month" in
- 3 Pennsylvania; and be it further
