A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and congratulating the United Way of Pennsylvania,

4 WHEREAS, Since its founding in 1966, the United Way of
5 Pennsylvania has been a leader in the Commonwealth's charitable
6 community; and

7 WHEREAS, The United Way of Pennsylvania and its affiliated
8 local entities provide for funding and logistical support for
9 critical human services programs in local communities, with a
10 focus on improving the health, education and financial stability
11 of every individual; and

12 WHEREAS, The 57 local United Way organizations in
13 Pennsylvania guide the charitable efforts in ways that reflect
14 each community's specific needs; and

15 WHEREAS, The leadership of the United Way is volunteer driven
16 and provides oversight and accountability on behalf of donors;

3 purposes through the United Way of Pennsylvania in 2015; and

4 WHEREAS, The United Way's volunteers commit many hours of

9 debates, including efficient human services delivery and early
