A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating March 31, 2017, as "C.A.S.U.A.L. Day" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Colon and rectal cancers are two of the most
4	frequently diagnosed cancers in northeastern Pennsylvania; and
5	WHEREAS, Incidence rates in some areas are as much as 17%
6	higher than the United States average, and mortality rates are
7	as much as 13% higher than the United States average; and
8	WHEREAS, Approximately 75% of new cases of colon and rectal
9	cancer occur in patients of average risk; and
10	WHEREAS, Approximately 911 new cases are diagnosed and
11	approximately 337 patients die from colon cancer each year in
12	the counties of Lackawanna, Luzerne, Monroe, Pike, Susquehanna,
13	Wayne and Wyoming combined; and
14	WHEREAS, The Northeast Regional Cancer Institute has been
15	easing the burden of cancer in northeastern Pennsylvania for

16 more than 25 years through community and patient services,

hospital and practice support services and cancer surveillance
 programs specifically designed to meet the region's unique
 needs; and

WHEREAS, On Friday, March 31, 2017, the Northeast Regional
Cancer Institute is sponsoring the 14th annual "C.A.S.U.A.L.
(Colon Cancer Awareness Saves Unlimited Adult Lives) Day" to
increase colon cancer awareness throughout northeastern
Pennsylvania; and

9 WHEREAS, "C.A.S.U.A.L. Day" was established by the family of 10 Helen Phillips, who fought a courageous battle against colon 11 cancer and died in the summer of 2002; therefore be it 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate March 13 31, 2017, as "C.A.S.U.A.L. Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it 14 further

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all residents of this Commonwealth to be screened for early detection of colon cancer and participate in and support the Northeast Regional Cancer Institute's colon cancer awareness efforts.
