## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the memory of law enforcement officers who gave their
- lives in the line of duty in this Commonwealth and
- 3 recognizing the memorial service in their honor at the
- 4 Pennsylvania State Museum in the City of Harrisburg on May 8,
- 5 2017.
- 6 WHEREAS, Police Officer Scott Leslie Bashioum, Trooper Landon
- 7 E. Weaver, Patrolman Edward Wehe and Police Officer Walter J.
- 8 DeWitt III made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty; and
- 9 WHEREAS, On November 10, 2016, Police Officer Scott Leslie
- 10 Bashioum, of the Canonsburg Borough Police Department, was shot
- 11 and killed while responding to a domestic disturbance call at a
- 12 residence in Canonsburg Borough, Washington County; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Officer Bashioum was approaching the residence with

- 1 his partner when the male subject shot at and seriously wounded
- 2 the two officers; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The subject shot and killed his pregnant wife before
- 4 committing suicide; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Both officers were immediately taken to Canonsburg
- 6 Hospital where Officer Bashioum succumbed to his wounds; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Officer Bashioum was a United States Air Force
- 8 veteran and had served with the Canonsburg Borough Police
- 9 Department for seven years; and
- 10 WHEREAS, He is survived by his wife and four children; and
- 11 WHEREAS, On December 30, 2016, Trooper Landon E. Weaver of
- 12 the Pennsylvania State Police, Troop G, was shot and killed
- 13 while responding to a domestic disturbance call at a residence
- 14 in Juniata Township, Huntingdon County; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Trooper Weaver was investigating a violation of a
- 16 protective order by a subject who had been recently released
- 17 from jail on bail; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The next morning, members of the Pennsylvania State
- 19 Police located the man who fatally shot Trooper Weaver and the
- 20 suspect was shot and killed when he pulled out a gun; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Trooper Weaver had served with the Pennsylvania
- 22 State Police for one year and is survived by his wife; and
- 23 WHEREAS, On November 5, 2013, Patrolman Edward Wehe suffered
- 24 a fatal heart attack shortly after clearing the scene of a
- 25 protest at the Delaware County Prison; and
- 26 WHEREAS, Patrolman Wehe had been dispatched to the prison to
- 27 assist in removing the protesters who had not obtained the
- 28 proper permits to assemble; and
- 29 WHEREAS, After Patrolman Wehe was able to clear the scene, he
- 30 went to a local restaurant where he ran into his daughter and

- 1 while speaking with her, suddenly collapsed; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Patrolman Wehe's daughter immediately initiated CPR
- 3 until medics arrived and he was transported to Riddle Memorial
- 4 Hospital where he passed away; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Patrolman Wehe was a United States Navy veteran,
- 6 served with the Delaware County Courthouse and Park Police
- 7 Department for 18 years and also served as a part-time officer
- 8 with the Marcus Hook Police Department; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Patrolman Wehe is survived by his daughter,
- 10 granddaughter, fiancée and brother; and
- 11 WHEREAS, On June 5, 2015, Police Officer Walter J. DeWitt
- 12 III, of the Philadelphia Police Department, died during surgery
- 13 from on-the-job health complications; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Officer DeWitt was a 33-year veteran and decorated
- 15 member of the Philadelphia Police Department; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Officer DeWitt is survived by his wife and son; and
- 17 WHEREAS, "National Police Memorial Day" is held on May 15
- 18 each year; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The week containing May 15 is celebrated each year
- 20 as "National Police Week"; and
- 21 WHEREAS, On October 1, 1962, Joint Resolution 730 of the 87th
- 22 Congress of the United States was signed, authorizing the
- 23 President of the United States to proclaim May 15 of each year
- 24 as "Peace Officers Memorial Day"; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Twenty years passed before the first "National
- 26 Police Memorial Day" was recognized May 15, 1982; and
- 27 WHEREAS, May 15 continues to be observed annually in memory
- 28 of police officers who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the
- 29 line of duty; and
- 30 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State Lodge of the Fraternal Order

- 1 of Police presents the annual memorial service in this
- 2 Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the
- 4 memories of Police Officer Scott Leslie Bashioum, Trooper Landon
- 5 E. Weaver, Patrolman Edward Wehe and Police Officer Walter J.
- 6 DeWitt III, who gave their lives in the line of duty in this
- 7 Commonwealth; and be it further
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 9 memorial service in their honor at the Pennsylvania State Museum
- 10 in the City of Harrisburg on May 8, 2017.
