A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the Congress of the United States to approve the
 2 Synthetic Trafficking and Overdose Prevention Act, which
 3 would close a dangerous loophole in Federal shipping law that
 4 allows illegal drugs to reach American soil.
- 5 WHEREAS, The United States is experiencing a drug overdose
- 6 epidemic; and
- 7 WHEREAS, More than 33,000 individuals died from synthetic
- 8 opioid overdoses in 2015; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Heroin overdoses killed nearly 13,000 individuals
- 10 across the nation that same year; and
- 11 WHEREAS, In Pennsylvania, an average of 67 individuals died
- 12 every week from drug overdoses, totaling nearly 3,500 overdose
- 13 deaths in 2015; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The deadly synthetic opioid fentanyl can be 40 times
- 15 more potent than heroin, with only a pinch needed to be lethal;
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, The U.S.-China Economic and Security Review
- 18 Commission found that the majority of fentanyl is created in

- 1 Chinese laboratories and shipped to the United States via the
- 2 United States Postal Service; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Unlike private parcel carriers, the United States
- 4 Postal Service does not require electronic customs data to be
- 5 sent in advance for postal shipments arriving from foreign
- 6 countries; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Advance customs data would provide United States
- 8 Customs and Border Protection personnel with crucial information
- 9 about a package's origin, destination and contents, better
- 10 enabling customs agents and Drug Enforcement Administration
- 11 officials to seize packages of illegal drugs; and
- 12 WHEREAS, An estimated 340 million packages enter the United
- 13 States without this data each year; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The Synthetic Trafficking and Overdose Prevention
- 15 Act would require postal shipments from foreign countries to
- 16 provide that vital customs data in advance; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 18 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress of the United
- 19 States to approve the Synthetic Trafficking and Overdose
- 20 Prevention Act; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 22 the President of the United States, the presiding officers of
- 23 each house of Congress and to each member of Congress from
- 24 Pennsylvania.
