A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the lives and memory of those killed and injured during 2 the bombing at the Ariana Grande concert at Manchester Arena
- in Manchester, England.
- WHEREAS, On May 22, 2017, at approximately 10:30 p.m. as
- 5 concert goers were leaving an Ariana Grande show at Manchester
- 6 Arena in Manchester, England, a bomb went off killing at least
- 7 22 people, injuring at least 59 others and leaving families
- 8 searching for their loved ones; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The bombing was determined to be a terrorist attack
- 10 targeting an audience made up mostly of young teenage girls,
- 11 shocking even by the standards of contemporary terrorism; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Islamic State claimed responsibility for the
- 13 suicide bombing; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Soft targets, including concert venues, are
- 2 generally attacked to try to intimidate and terrify people and
- 3 often instill the greatest amount of fear in everyday life; and
- 4 WHEREAS, In the chaotic aftermath of the explosion, police
- 5 and other first responders rushed to the explosion and risked
- 6 their lives to save others; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Medical professionals worked tirelessly, taxi
- 8 drivers offered free rides and local residents opened their
- 9 homes to those who were in need; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The United Kingdom has now raised their threat level
- 11 from severe to critical and authorities are on alert for other
- 12 potential imminent terror attacks that may occur; and
- 13 WHEREAS, What had been planned to be a fun night for many,
- 14 turned tragic in the blink of an eye; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the lives
- 16 and memory of those killed and injured during the bombing at the
- 17 Ariana Grande concert at Manchester Arena in Manchester,
- 18 England; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives extend
- 20 condolences to their families and concern for those injured and
- 21 missing and express gratitude to all emergency workers, first
- 22 responders and volunteers for their efforts.
