## A RESOLUTION

Directing the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to conduct a study of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Council 2 on the Arts' funding formula and how resources are allocated 3 for this Commonwealth's African-American, Latin, Asian-4 5 American and Native American, newer and rural artistic organizations. 6 7 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth's numerous art organizations are key actors in the economic, educational and social prosperity of Pennsylvania; and 10 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth's art organizations provide valuable instructive and cultural experiences to citizens of all 11 12 ages; and 13 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth's art organizations have a significant economic impact and provide for tourism dollars; and 14 15 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth's art organizations tackle a 16 variety of art forms from fine art to extremely abstract art; 17 and 18 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth funds its art organizations through 19 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Council on the Arts which utilizes a weighted funding formula to allocate those funds; and 20

- 1 WHEREAS, It is recognized by council members on the
- 2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Council on the Arts that the
- 3 current funding formula advantages arts organizations that are
- 4 older, that have larger budgets and that tend to be
- 5 predominantly white in staff, board and audience while
- 6 disadvantaging organizations that are newer, with smaller
- 7 budgets and that are disproportionately staffed and governed by
- 8 members of the African-American, Latin, Asian-American and
- 9 Native American communities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, A new funding formula is proposed that is weighted
- 11 to provide greater opportunities for multicultural arts
- 12 organizations, arts organizations formed after the year 2000 or
- 13 arts organizations with an annual budget under \$200,000;
- 14 therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
- 16 conduct a study of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Council on
- 17 the Arts' current funding formula as well as alternative funding
- 18 formulas that are weighted to provide greater opportunities for
- 19 newer, multicultural, rural and LGBT arts organizations; and be
- 20 it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That the study include an analysis of the current
- 22 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Council on the Arts' funding in the
- 23 annual Commonwealth budget; and be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
- 25 provide recommendations necessary or desirable to improve the
- 26 funding equity of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Council on
- 27 the Arts' funding formula; and be it further
- 28 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
- 29 report to the House of Representatives the result of its study
- 30 and recommendations regarding the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 1 Council on the Arts' funding formula and file the report with
- 2 the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives no later than
- 3 180 days after the adoption of this resolution.
