- 7 WHEREAS, Eunice Kennedy Shriver was the founder of the
- 8 Special Olympics, empowering athletes with intellectual
- 9 disabilities to develop self-confidence and become leaders, so
- 10 that they can have a say in how individuals are treated; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Eunice Kennedy Shriver created the first
- 12 international Special Olympics Games on July 20, 1968,
- 13 consisting of 1,000 athletes competing in three sports, track
- 14 and field, swimming and floor hockey; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Special Olympics Pennsylvania was founded in May
- 16 1970 when 135 athletes with intellectual disabilities competed
- 17 at a track and field event held at West Chester University; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Former Pennsylvania Governor Raymond Shafer marked
- 2 the week Special Olympics Pennsylvania was founded, May 24
- 3 through May 30, 1970, as "Special Olympics Week" in
- 4 Pennsylvania; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Special Olympics Pennsylvania now serves almost
- 6 20,000 athletes with intellectual disabilities who participate
- 7 in 21 Olympic-style sports at no cost to them, their families or
- 8 their caregivers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Special Olympics' continuing efforts to change
- 10 society's perspective of people with disabilities by showcasing
- 11 their abilities is the inspirational legacy of Eunice Kennedy
- 12 Shriver; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate July
- 14 20, 2017, as "Eunice Kennedy Shriver Day" in Pennsylvania in
- 15 honor of the amazing accomplishments of Special Olympics'
