## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the 100th anniversary of the creation of the
- 2 International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF) and
- honoring the IAFF and its membership on this momentous and
- 4 important occasion.
- 5 WHEREAS, The International Association of Fire Fighters
- 6 (IAFF) was officially formed at precisely 2:00 p.m. Eastern
- 7 Standard Time on February 28, 1918, to unite firefighters for
- 8 better wages, improved safety and greater service to their
- 9 communities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, One hundred years ago, 36 delegates from the
- 11 original 24 local unions came together to form the IAFF, at a
- 12 time when firefighters worked seven days a week and had few
- 13 benefits and when safety meant putting a wet towel over your
- 14 face before running into flames; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The IAFF became the voice of the firefighter and the
- 16 protector of the protector; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Pittsburgh firefighters organized in 1903 under the
- 2 affiliation of the American Federation of Labor Local 11431 and
- 3 would become the very first local under IAFF, Local 1, when the
- 4 IAFF was officially formed in 1918; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Since Pittsburgh, the IAFF has grown to represent
- 6 firefighters in Philadelphia, Scranton, Lancaster, Allentown,
- 7 Reading, Johnstown, Altoona, Dunmore, Harrisburg, Bethlehem,
- 8 Hazelton, Aliquippa, Chester, Lebanon and countless departments
- 9 throughout this Commonwealth; and
- 10 WHEREAS, With headquarters in Washington, DC, and Ottawa,
- 11 Ontario, Canada, the IAFF proudly represents more than 310,000
- 12 full-time professional firefighters and paramedics in more than
- 13 3,200 affiliates who are part of a coveted profession that
- 14 requires extensive skill, training and dedication and who
- 15 protect more than 85% of the population in communities
- 16 throughout the United States and Canada; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The IAFF and its members help to make a positive
- 18 impact on firefighters' jobs, livelihoods, health and retirement
- 19 security and ensure that this noble profession continues to be
- 20 as safe as it can be; therefore be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 22 100th anniversary of the creation and formation of the
- 23 International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF) and honor the
- 24 IAFF and its membership on this momentous and important
- 25 occasion.
