- 11 Abuse Resistance Education (D.A.R.E.) programs in our
- 12 communities and honors participating students, officers, schools
- 13 and law enforcement agencies; and

- exemplary students who have made a commitment to remain drug-15

- 2 WHEREAS, Graduates of the program contribute to the safety of
- 3 our communities by resisting unsafe behaviors, having learned
- 4 that violence and substance abuse affect a user, as well as a
