## A RESOLUTION

- Designating May 23, 2018, as "Emergency Medical Services for Children Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, More than 30 million children receive emergency
- 4 medical care each year due to illness or injury; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The needs of children are different than the needs
- 6 of adults in medical emergencies; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The goal of Emergency Medical Services for Children
- 8 is to help states and communities prepare for a
- 9 medical/traumatic emergency involving a child through the
- 10 provision of properly trained emergency personnel, sufficiently
- 11 equipped ambulances, pediatric-ready emergency departments and
- 12 well-defined pediatric treatment protocols and procedures; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Emergency Medical Services for Children relies on
- 14 its established partnership within the emergency medical
- 15 services (EMS) community, as well as physicians and nurses who

- 1 provide pediatric emergency care to help states and communities
- 2 reduce child and youth disability and death due to severe
- 3 illness or injury; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Emergency Medical Services for Children, the tens of
- 5 thousands of EMS providers and acute care professionals it
- 6 services and the more than 25 professional organizations in
- 7 which it partners are committed to improving the quality of
- 8 emergency care children receive; and
- 9 WHEREAS, It is proper and timely to bring recognition to the
- 10 value and accomplishments of Emergency Medical Service for
- 11 Children and the dedicated men and women who work tirelessly to
- 12 improve the quality of pediatric medical care; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 23,
- 14 2018, as "Emergency Medical Services for Children Day" in
- 15 Pennsylvania.
