1 including \$402 million in government revenue, and supports the 2 full-time equivalent of 100,000 jobs; therefore be it 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the 4 month of October 2018 as "National Arts and Humanities Month" in

5 Pennsylvania; and be it further

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives call upon 7 residents to celebrate and promote the arts and culture in our 8 nation and encourage greater participation by residents of this 9 Commonwealth in the arts and humanities in their local 10 communities.
