AN ACT

- Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania
 Consolidated Statutes, in ethics standards and financial
 disclosure, further providing for definitions, for restricted
 activities, for statement of financial interests and for
 penalties.

 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 hereby enacts as follows:

 Section 1. Section 1102 of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania

- 18 Section 2. Section 1103 of Title 65 is amended by adding a
- 19 subsection to read:

- 1 § 1103. Restricted activities.
- 2 * * *
- 3 (c.1) Accepting a gift of cash.--
- 4 (1) No public official, public employee or nominee or
- 5 <u>candidate for public office may solicit or accept a gift of</u>
- 6 <u>cash</u>.
- 7 (2) This subsection does not apply to any gift or gifts
- 8 received from a spouse, parent, parent by marriage, sibling,
- 9 child, grandchild, other family member or friend when the
- 10 circumstances make it clear that the motivation for the
- 11 <u>action was a personal or family relationship.</u>
- 12 (3) For the purposes of this subsection, the term
- 13 <u>"friend" does not include a registered lobbyist or an</u>
- 14 employee of a registered lobbyist.

- Section 3. Section 1105(b) and (c) of Title 65 are amended
- 17 and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

- 20 (b) Required information. -- The statement shall include the
- 21 following information for the prior calendar year with regard to
- 22 the person required to file the statement:
- 23 (1) Name, address and public position.
- 24 (2) Occupation or profession.
- 25 (3) Any direct or indirect interest in any real estate
- 26 which was sold or leased to the Commonwealth, any of its
- 27 agencies or political subdivisions, or purchased or leased
- from the Commonwealth, any of its agencies or political
- subdivisions, or which was the subject of any condemnation
- 30 proceedings by the Commonwealth, any of its agencies or

- 2 (4) The name and address of each creditor to whom is 3 owed in excess of \$6,500 and the interest rate thereon. 4 However, loans or credit extended between members of the 5 immediate family and mortgages securing real property which
- 6 is the principal or secondary residence of the person filing
- 7 shall not be included.

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- 8 (5) The name and address of any direct or indirect
 9 source of income totaling in the aggregate \$1,300 or more.
 10 However, this provision shall not be construed to require the

 12 or existing professional codes of ethics or common law
- 14 The name and address of the source and the amount of 15 any gift [or gifts valued in the aggregate at \$250 or] of 16 more than \$50 and the circumstances of each gift. This 17 paragraph shall not apply to a gift or gifts received from a 18 spouse, parent, parent by marriage, sibling, child, 19 grandchild, other family member or friend when the 20 circumstances make it clear that the motivation for the 21 action was a personal or family relationship. - 17 payment or reimbursement that is below the monetary threshold
- 18 for reporting under subsection (b) (6) or (7).
- 19 (c) Reporting amounts.--Except [where an amount is] <u>as</u>
- 20 required to be reported pursuant to subsection (b)(6) and (7),
- 21 the statement of financial interests need not include specific
- 22 amounts for the items required to be listed.

- Section 4. Section 1109(a) of Title 65 is amended to read:
- 25 § 1109. Penalties.
- 26 (a) Restricted activities violation. -- Any person who
- 27 violates the provisions of section 1103(a), (b) [and (c)], (c)
- 28 <u>and (c.1)</u> (relating to restricted activities) commits a felony
- 29 and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not
- 30 more than \$10,000 or to imprisonment for not more than five

- 1 years, or both.
