AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in sentencing, providing 2 for lottery winnings intercept. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 7 8 § 9778. Lottery winnings intercept. 9 (a) Duty of Department of Revenue. -- In the case of a person 10 claiming Pennsylvania State Lottery winnings that exceed \$2,500, 11 the Department of Revenue, after it has made its determination subject to 23 Pa.C.S. § 4308 (relating to lottery winnings 12 13 intercept), shall: (1) in consultation with the Administrative Office of 14 15 Pennsylvania Courts, make a reasonable effort to determine if the person owes a court-ordered obligation prior to making a 16 17 lottery winnings payment;

(2) if the person is found to owe a court-ordered

- 1 <u>obligation</u>, intercept and deduct the amount owed in the
- 2 court-ordered obligation from the amount of lottery winnings
- and remit the amount to the Administrative Office of
- 4 <u>Pennsylvania Courts for distribution under applicable law;</u>
- 5 (3) notify the claimant of a payment made under this
- 6 section; and
- 7 (4) pay the remaining lottery winnings to the claimant.
- 8 (b) Right to review. -- A person whose lottery winnings are
- 9 <u>used to satisfy an obligation under this section may appeal in</u>
- 10 <u>accordance with applicable law. The appeal must be filed within</u>
- 11 30 days after the person is notified by the Department of
- 12 Revenue that the winnings have been reduced or totally withheld
- 13 to satisfy the person's outstanding court-ordered obligation.
- 14 <u>(c) Administrative fee.--The Department of Revenue may</u>
- 15 <u>determine and set a fee to cover actual costs to administer this</u>
- 16 section and may deduct the calculated amount from the lottery
- 17 winnings subject to intercept under this section.
- 18 (d) Rules and regulations. -- The Department of Revenue, in
- 19 conjunction with the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania
- 20 Courts, may, in the manner provided by law, jointly promulgate
- 21 the rules and regulations necessary to carry out this section.
- 22 (e) Duty of Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts.--
- 23 The Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts shall provide
- 24 to the Department of Revenue the information necessary to
- 25 fulfill its duties under this section.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
