1 2 3 4	Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in lobbying disclosure, further providing for registration, for reporting and for registration fees, fund established, system and regulations.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Sections 13A04(a), (d) and (e)(1), 13A05(a), (b)
8	(4), (6) and (8) and (d) and 13A10(c) of Title 65 of the
9	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
10	§ 13A04. Registration.
11	(a) General ruleUnless excluded under section 13A06
12	(relating to exemption from registration and reporting), a
13	lobbyist, lobbying firm or a principal must register with the
14	department electronically using the computerized filing system
15	developed by the department that is consistent with the purpose
16	of this chapter within ten days of acting in any capacity as a
17	lobbyist, lobbying firm or principal. Registration shall be
18	biennial and shall begin January 1, 2007.

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2 (d) Amendments.--

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(1) If there is a change of information required for the
registration statement under subsection (b)(1) or (2) or (c),
an amended registration statement shall be filed with the
department <u>electronically using the computerized filing</u>
<u>system developed by the department that is consistent with</u>
<u>the purpose of this chapter</u> within 14 days after the change
occurs.

10 (2) When there is a change in information required for 11 the registration statement under subsection (b)(3), an 12 amended registration statement shall be filed with the 13 department <u>electronically using the computerized filing</u> 14 <u>system developed by the department that is consistent with</u> 15 <u>the purpose of this chapter</u> within 14 days of the end of the 16 year in which the change occurs.

17 (e) Termination.--

(1) A lobbyist, lobbying firm or principal may terminate
registration by filing notice of termination with the
department[.] <u>electronically using the computerized filing</u>
<u>system developed by the department that is consistent with</u>
<u>the purpose of this chapter.</u>

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24 § 13A05. Reporting.

* * *

(a) General rule.--A registered principal shall, under oath
or affirmation, file quarterly expense reports with the
department <u>electronically using the computerized filing system</u>
<u>developed by the department that is consistent with the purpose</u>
<u>of this chapter</u> no later than 30 days after the last day of the
quarter.

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- 1 (b) Content.--
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3 (4) A lobbying firm or a lobbyist not associated with a lobbying firm shall sign the reports <u>electronically</u> submitted 4 5 by each principal for whom the lobbying firm or lobbyist is 6 registered to attest to the validity and accuracy to the best 7 of the attestor's knowledge. A lobbying firm or lobbyist may 8 attach a statement to the electronic report of a principal, 9 describing the limits of the knowledge of the lobbying firm 10 or lobbyist concerning the information contained in the 11 expense report.

13 (6) A lobbying firm or a lobbyist not associated with a 14 lobbying firm shall submit an expense report <u>electronically</u> 15 using the computerized filing system developed by the 16 department that is consistent with the purpose of this 17 chapter if during the reporting period the lobbying firm or 18 lobbyist engaged in lobbying which was not contained in any expense report filed by a principal or principals 19 20 represented.

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22 (8) A lobbying firm or a lobbyist not associated with a 23 lobbying firm shall submit a report <u>electronically using the</u> 24 computerized filing system developed by the department that 25 is consistent with the purpose of this chapter if the 26 lobbying firm or lobbyist engaged in lobbying on behalf of 27 any entity that is exempt under section 13A06(7), (8), (9) or 28 (10) (relating to exemption from registration and reporting). * * * 29

30 (d) Thresholds for reporting.--An expense report required 20170SB0169PN0145 - 3 -

1 under this section shall be filed <u>electronically using the</u> computerized filing system developed by the department that is 2 consistent with the purpose of this chapter when total expenses 3 for lobbying exceed \$2,500 for a registered principal in a 4 reporting period. In a reporting period in which total expenses 5 are \$2,500 or less, a statement to that effect shall be filed[.] 6 7 electronically using the computerized filing system developed by the department that is consistent with the purpose of this 8 9 chapter. * * * 10 11 § 13A10. Registration fees; fund established; system; 12 regulations. * * * 13 (c) Computerized filing system. -- The department shall 14 15 implement a fully accessible system to accommodate the use of 16 computerized filing. [Each registrant shall elect on an annual 17 basis whether the registrant will file all of the documents 18 required by this chapter either electronically or on paper with 19 the department.] The department shall post all filings on its 20 publicly accessible Internet website within seven days of 21 receipt of the filing. * * * 22 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect as follows: 24 The amendment of 65 Pa.C.S. §§ 13A04(a), (d) and (1)25 (e) (1) and 13A05(a), (b) (4), (6) and (8) and (d) shall take 26 effect January 1, 2018. 27 The remainder of this act shall take effect (2) 28 immediately.

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
