## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in assault, providing for the offense of threat against law enforcement officer or sheriff.

5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 2702.2. Threat against law enforcement officer or sheriff.
9	(a) Offense defined A person who threatens the following <-
10	ANOTHER with death or serious bodily injury commits an offense <-
11	under this section IF THE PERSON KNOWS OR HAS REASON TO KNOW <-
12	THAT THE PERSON IS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
13	(1) A law enforcement officer.
14	(2) A sheriff or deputy sheriff.
15	(3) A family or household member of an individual under
16	paragraph (1) or (2).
17	(b) Grading
18	(1) A first offense under this section constitutes a

- 2 (2) A second or subsequent offense under this section
- 3 <u>constitutes a felony of the second degree.</u>
- 4 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 5 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 6 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 7 <u>"Family or household member." Spouses or persons who have</u>
- 8 been spouses, persons living as spouses or who lived as spouses,
- 9 parents and children, other persons related by consanguinity or
- 10 affinity, current or former sexual or intimate partners or
- 11 persons who share biological parenthood.
- "Law enforcement officer." As the term "peace officer" is
- 13 <u>defined under section 501 (relating to definitions).</u>
- 14 <u>"Serious bodily injury." Impairment of physical condition or</u>
- 15 substantial pain that creates a substantial risk of death or
- 16 that causes serious permanent disfigurement or protracted loss
- 17 or impairment of function of any bodily member or organ.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
