## AN ACT

7	Section 1. Section 7412 of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding definitions to read:
9	§ 7412. Definitions.
10	The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
11	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
12	context clearly indicates otherwise:
13	"Commissioner." The Office of the State Fire Commissioner.

15	"Length of service award program." A system established to
16	provide tax-deferred income benefits to active volunteer members
17	<u>of a fire service.</u>

Section 2. Section 7413 introductory paragraph and (4) of
 Title 35 are amended and the section is amended by adding a
 paragraph to read:

4 § 7413. Statement of purpose.

5 The purpose of this subchapter is to encourage individuals to 6 take part in the fire service as volunteer firefighters by 7 establishing criteria and standards for orderly administration 8 and conduct of affairs of firefighters' relief associations to ensure, as far as circumstances will reasonably permit, that 9 funds shall be available for the assistance to and protection of 10 11 volunteer firefighters and their heirs in order to provide: \* \* \* 12

13 (4) Safeguards for preserving life, health and safety of 14 volunteer firefighters to ensure their availability to 15 participate in the fire service, including necessary 16 training.

18 (6.1) Financial assistance to recruit and retain

25 (f) Use.--Funds of any volunteer firefighters' relief 26 association may be spent:

(11) To purchase safeguards for preserving life, health
 and safety of volunteer firefighters to ensure their
 availability to participate in the volunteer fire service,

8 Section 4. Section 7418 of Title 35 is amended to read:9 § 7418. Audits.

10 (a) General rule.--

(1) The Office of Auditor General shall have the power 11 12 and its duty shall be to audit the accounts and records of 13 every volunteer firefighters' relief association receiving 14 money under Chapter 7 of the act of December 18, 1984 15 (P.L.1005, No.205), known as the Municipal Pension Plan 16 Funding Standard and Recovery Act, as far as may be necessary 17 to satisfy the Auditor General that the money received was or 18 is being expended for no purpose other than that authorized 19 by this subchapter. Copies of all audits shall be furnished 20 to the Governor.

(2) The commissioner shall establish and publish
 annually, in consultation with the Auditor General, eligible
 uses of the money in accordance with this subchapter.

24 (3) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), the commissioner
 25 shall maintain authority relating to the eligible uses of
 26 money received.

(b) Findings.--If the Auditor General finds that [any] money received by a volunteer firefighters' relief association has been expended for a purpose other than one authorized by this subchapter, the Auditor General shall immediately notify the

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Governor <u>and the commissioner</u> and shall decline to approve
 further requisitions calling for payment to the volunteer
 firefighters' relief association until the improperly expended
 amount has been reimbursed to the relief association fund.
 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
