## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 1 2 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 3 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 6 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," in entertainment production tax credit, further 10 providing for limitations. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 13 hereby enacts as follows:
- 14 Section 1. Section 1716-D(a) of the act of March 4, 1971
- 15 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, amended
- 16 July 13, 2016 (P.L.526, No.84), is amended to read:
- 17 Section 1716-D. Limitations.
- 18 Cap. -- Except for tax credits reissued under section
- 19 1761.1-D, in no case shall the aggregate amount of tax credits
- 20 awarded in any fiscal year under this subarticle exceed
- 21 [\$65,000,000] \$125,000,000. The department may, in its
- 22 discretion, award in one fiscal year up to:

- 1 (1) Thirty percent of the dollar amount of film
- 2 production tax credits available to be awarded in the next
- 3 succeeding fiscal year.
- 4 (2) Twenty percent of the dollar amount of film
- 5 production tax credits available to be awarded in the second
- 6 successive fiscal year.
- 7 (3) Ten percent of the dollar amount of film production
- 8 tax credits available to be awarded in the third successive
- 9 fiscal year.

- 11 Section 2. The amendment of section 1716-D(a) shall apply to
- 12 fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 2017.
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
