AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in powers of department and local authorities,  
3 further providing for specific powers of department and local  
4 authorities.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 6109 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:  
9 § 6109. Specific powers of department and local authorities.

11 (i) Delegation of powers in cities of the second class A and  
12 third class.--

13 (1) Notwithstanding a provision of 53 Pa.C.S. Ch. 55 or  
14 this title to the contrary, beginning January 1, 2018, the  
15 parking authority of a city of the second class A or city of  
16 the third class may enforce and administer ordinances and  
17 resolutions enacted or adopted by the city of the second  
18 class A or city of the third class under the powers specified  
19 under subsection (a)(1) and those certain stopping, standing

1 and parking provisions provided in sections 3351, 3353 and  
2 3354.

3 (2) Beginning March 1, 2018, the parking authority of a  
4 city of the second class A or city of the third class may  
5 enter into an agreement with the city of the second class A  
6 or city of the third class for the transfer of a portion of  
7 the fines, penalties and costs collected under this  
8 subsection, which the parking authority board deems  
9 reasonable, to the city of the second class A or city of the  
10 third class.

11 (3) As used in this subsection, the following words and  
12 phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this  
13 paragraph:

14 "Administer." To provide any services or materials  
15 necessary to enforce any ordinance or resolution enacted in  
16 order to regulate or prohibit the stopping, standing or  
17 parking of motor vehicles in a city of the second class A or  
18 city of the third class or those certain stopping, standing  
19 and parking provisions provided in sections 3351, 3353 and  
20 3354, including, but not limited to:

21 (i) The installation and maintenance of all  
22 equipment, including parking meters, on and along  
23 highways, streets and roadways.

24 (ii) The installation and maintenance of all  
25 signage, including signage for handicapped parking,  
26 residential permit parking and loading areas, on and  
27 along highways, streets and roadways.

28 (iii) The operation and management of any  
29 handicapped parking, residential parking and loading area  
30 permit programs.

1           (iv) The adjudication of all disputed parking  
2           violation notices or citations issued through enforcement  
3           by the parking authority in a city of the second class A  
4           or city of the third class.

5           "Enforce." The issuance of parking violation notices or  
6           citations, the immobilization, towing and impoundment of  
7           motor vehicles and the collection of fines, penalties and  
8           costs, including independent collection agency fees, for  
9           violations of any ordinance or resolution enacted in order to  
10           regulate or prohibit the stopping, standing or parking of  
11           motor vehicles in a city of the second class A and city of  
12           the third class and those certain stopping, standing and  
13           parking provisions provided in sections 3351, 3353 and 3354.  
14           Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
