## AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing the purchase of health insurance from out-of-State insurers.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Foreign
- 7 Health Insurance Purchase Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Department." The Insurance Department of the Commonwealth.
- 13 "Foreign insurer." Any of the following entities, if
- 14 licensed by another state to sell health insurance in that state
- 15 and if not prohibited under the laws of that state from selling
- 16 health insurance to the residents of this Commonwealth:
- 17 (1) an insurance company;
- 18 (2) an association;

- 1 (3) an exchange;
- 2 (4) an interinsurance exchange;
- 3 (5) a health maintenance organization;
- 4 (6) a preferred provider organization;
- 5 (7) a professional health services plan corporation;
- 6 (8) a hospital plan corporation;
- 7 (9) a fraternal benefits society;
- 8 (10) a beneficial association;
- 9 (11) a Lloyd's insurer; or
- 10 (12) a health plan corporation.
- 11 "Health insurance." An individual or group health insurance
- 12 policy, subscriber contract, certificate or plan that provides
- 13 medical or health care coverage by a health care facility or
- 14 licensed health care provider.
- 15 Section 3. Right to purchase health insurance from foreign
- insurers.
- 17 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a
- 18 resident of this Commonwealth shall have the right to purchase
- 19 health insurance from a foreign insurer, regardless of whether
- 20 the foreign insurer is licensed or in compliance with the laws
- 21 of this Commonwealth.
- 22 Section 4. Public notice.
- The department shall publish a notice on its publicly
- 24 accessible Internet website that explains the right of a
- 25 resident of this Commonwealth under this act to purchase health
- 26 insurance from a foreign insurer. The department may include in
- 27 the notice information that a resident might find helpful in
- 28 making a decision to purchase health insurance from a foreign
- 29 insurer.
- 30 Section 5. Effective date.

1 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
