- Designating the intersection of Pennsylvania Route 41 (Gap
 Newport Pike) and Pennsylvania Route 926 (Street Road) over
 U.S. Route 1 located in London Grove Township, Chester
 County, as the Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial Highway.

 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 hereby enacts as follows:

 Section 1. Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial Highway.

 (a) Findings.—The General Assembly finds and declares as
 follows:
- 10 (1) Trooper Kenton Iwaniec was born on December 18,
- 11 1983, in Greensburg, Westmoreland County, son of Ken and Deb
- 12 Iwaniec.
- 13 (2) Trooper Iwaniec graduated from Saint Vincent College
- on May 11, 2007, and enlisted in the Pennsylvania State
- 15 Police on June 11, 2007.
- 16 (3) On March 27, 2008, Trooper Iwaniec finished his
- shift at the Avondale Barracks in Chester County and began
- 18 his drive home.
- 19 (4) At approximately 10:15 p.m., just two miles away

- 1 from the Avondale Barracks, a vehicle driven by an impaired
- 2 driver crossed the centerline of Pennsylvania Route 41 and
- 3 hit Trooper Iwaniec's vehicle head-on.
- 4 (5) Trooper Iwaniec was flown to Christiana Hospital in
- 5 Delaware where he passed away two hours later from injuries
- 6 sustained in the collision.
- 7 (6) The family of Trooper Iwaniec continues to raise
- 8 awareness about the seriousness of impaired driving through
- 9 the formation of the Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial
- 10 Foundation.
- 11 (7) The Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial Foundation
- 12 encourages communities to have a positive influence in the
- 13 reduction of impaired driving.
- 14 (8) The mission of the Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial
- 15 Foundation is to honor the memory of all driving under the
- influence (DUI) victims and raise funds through events to
- 17 purchase preliminary breath-testing devices for the
- Pennsylvania State Police and other law enforcement agencies
- 19 throughout this Commonwealth.
- 20 (b) Designation. -- The intersection of Pennsylvania Route 41
- 21 (Gap Newport Pike) and Pennsylvania Route 926 (Street Road) over
- 22 U.S. Route 1 located in London Grove Township, Chester County,
- 23 is designated the Trooper Kenton Iwaniec Memorial Highway.
- 24 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 25 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 26 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 27 Section 2. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
