A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of February 2017 as "Black History Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, It is the duty of society to recognize those
- 4 individuals within its borders who have contributed greatly to
- 5 the quality of life therein; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The contributions of African-American residents as
- 7 scientists, inventors, farmers, educators, homemakers, explorers
- 8 and countless other professions have greatly benefited this
- 9 Commonwealth and our nation; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Multiethnicity and multiculturalism is encouraged
- 11 with an increased awareness of the important role that African
- 12 Americans have played throughout the history of this
- 13 Commonwealth and our nation; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Carter Godwin Woodson, an African-American
- 15 historian, recognized these contributions and accomplishments
- 16 and on February 7, 1926, created a cultural landmark known as
- 17 "Negro History Week"; and

- 1 WHEREAS, "Negro History Week" was changed to "Black History
- 2 Week" during the Civil Rights Movement in the 1960s and was
- 3 subsequently expanded to "Black History Month"; and
- 4 WHEREAS, "Black History Month" was officially recognized in
- 5 the United States as part of the bicentennial celebration and
- 6 has continued to be a monthlong celebration each year since
- 7 1976; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Regarding "Black History Month," President Gerald
- 9 Ford urged Americans to "seize the opportunity to honor the too-
- 10 often neglected accomplishments of black Americans in every area
- 11 of endeavor throughout our history"; and
- 12 WHEREAS, "Black History Month" is an opportunity for all
- 13 Americans to commemorate the struggles and victories of African
- 14 Americans in our history and their invaluable contributions to
- 15 society and to the defense of our nation in war and peace;
- 16 therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of February
- 18 2017 as "Black History Month" in Pennsylvania in recognition of
- 19 the contributions of the African-American community to this
- 20 Commonwealth and our nation and encourage all residents of this
- 21 Commonwealth to seek increased awareness and understanding of
- 22 these contributions through historical study.
