- WHEREAS, The week of May 7 through 13, 2017, has been
- 5 selected as "National Travel and Tourism Week," and May 9, 2017,
- 6 has been selected as "Tourism Day" in Pennsylvania; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The travel and tourism industry of this Commonwealth
- 8 has selected May 9, 2017, as "Tourism Day," which is officially
- 9 being called "Travel Rally Day"; and
- 10 WHEREAS, "National Tourism Week" was established in 1983 when
- 11 the Congress of the United States passed a joint resolution
- 12 designating a week in May 1984 as "National Tourism Week" and,
- 13 in a White House ceremony, the President of the United States
- 14 signed a Presidential proclamation urging citizens to observe
- 15 the week with the appropriate ceremonies and activities; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Tourism is Pennsylvania's second-largest industry
- 17 and a major contributor to the economy of this Commonwealth,

- 1 accounting for an annual economic impact of \$41 billion; and
- WHEREAS, Tourism supports a work force of more than 489,000
- 3 individuals, with 1 out of every 16 Pennsylvania jobs relying on
- 4 travel and tourism and related industries; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is one of the most-visited states in
- 6 the country, with an estimated 193 million visits by leisure and
- 7 business travelers annually; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Many small businesses are involved in the tourism
- 9 industry, and the hotels, restaurants, bed and breakfasts and
- 10 attractions that are run by these small businesses constitute an
- 11 important and vital segment of local economies across this
- 12 Commonwealth; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize May 7 through 13, 2017,
- 14 as "National Travel and Tourism Week" and May 9, 2017, as
- 15 "Travel Rally Day" in Pennsylvania.
