## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the week of September 24 through 30, 2017, as
- "National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week" in
- 3 Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, The literacy of our residents is essential for the
- 5 economic well-being of this Commonwealth and allows residents to
- 6 fully participate in the processes of government; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Literacy and education are a prerequisite to
- 8 individuals achieving the full benefit of opportunities in our
- 9 communities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The economy and our position in the global economy
- 11 depend on having a literate, skilled population; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Parents who read to their children and parents'
- 13 education levels have a direct impact on the educational success
- 14 of their children; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Thirteen percent of adults in this Commonwealth lack
- 16 the reading, math or English skills to read a prescription and
- 17 follow medical instructions, endangering their lives and the
- 18 lives of their loved ones; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Many individuals who are unemployed, underemployed
- 2 or receive public assistance lack the literacy skills to obtain
- 3 and keep a job with family-sustaining income, continue their
- 4 education or participate in job training programs; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Many high school dropouts do not have the literacy
- 6 skills to complete their education, transition to postsecondary
- 7 education or vocational training or become employed; and
- 8 WHEREAS, "National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week"
- 9 highlights the need for the nation to support efforts to ensure
- 10 that all individuals have the necessary literacy skills to
- 11 succeed at home, at work and in society; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Senate supports educators and students enrolled
- 13 in educational programs throughout this Commonwealth; therefore
- 14 be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the week of September 24
- 16 through 30, 2017, as "National Adult Education and Family
- 17 Literacy Week" in Pennsylvania and encourage all residents of
- 18 this Commonwealth to participate in literacy activities that
- 19 support and strengthen family bonds.
