A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of September 17 through 21, 2018, as 1 "SepticSmart Week" in Pennsylvania to increase awareness of 2 the importance of proper maintenance and service of on-lot 3 septic systems. 5 WHEREAS, More than 40% of Pennsylvanians rely on septic systems; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's on-lot septic systems are a natural, environmentally friendly method of treating household water 8 without straining local waste treatment facilities; and WHEREAS, Average indoor use of water in a typical single-10 family home is nearly 150 gallons a day and filters through a 11 septic system where beneficial living organisms digest and break 12
- 14 WHEREAS, Proper maintenance of an on-lot septic system is
- 15 necessary to avoid tens of thousands of dollars in repair costs;

- 18 lot septic systems risk overloading the system which can cause

- 3 WHEREAS, Professional septic system providers and the United
- 4 States Environmental Protection Agency recommend periodic
- 5 pumping and maintenance of an on-lot septic system; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The National Onsite Wastewater Recycling Association
- 7 and the Pennsylvania Septage Management Association have search
- 8 engines to help consumers locate providers who will advise them
- 9 on establishing proper maintenance and service schedules for
- 10 their on-lot septic systems; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Efforts should be made to promote awareness of the
- 12 importance of properly maintaining and servicing an on-lot
- 13 septic system; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Members of the Pennsylvania Septage Management
- 15 Association have made consumer education a major priority;
- 16 therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of September 17
- 18 through 21, 2018, as "SepticSmart Week" in Pennsylvania to
- 19 increase awareness of the importance of proper maintenance and
- 20 service of on-lot septic systems.
