## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 3 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain 7 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," in personal income tax, providing for 10 contribution for Veterans' Trust Fund. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as 14 the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by adding a section to 15 16 read: 17 Section 315.14. Contribution for Veterans' Trust Fund. -- (a) 18 Beginning with taxable years ending after December 31, 2019, the

department shall provide a space on the Pennsylvania individual

- 1 designate a contribution, in an amount of not less than five
- 2 dollars (\$5), to the Veterans' Trust Fund. The amount so
- 3 <u>designated</u> shall be deducted from the tax refund to which the
- 4 <u>individual is entitled and shall not constitute a charge against</u>
- 5 the income tax revenues due to the Commonwealth.
- 6 (b) The department shall determine annually the total amount
- 7 <u>designated under this section</u>, <u>less reasonable administrative</u>
- 8 costs, and shall report the amount to the State Treasurer who
- 9 shall transfer the amount to the Veterans' Trust Fund.
- 10 <u>(c) The department shall provide adequate information</u>
- 11 concerning the checkoff for the Veterans' Trust Fund in its
- 12 <u>instructions which accompany the Pennsylvania income tax return</u>
- 13 forms. The information concerning the checkoff shall include the
- 14 <u>listing of an address furnished by the Department of Military</u>
- 15 and Veterans Affairs to which contributions may be sent by
- 16 taxpayers wishing to contribute to this effort but who do not
- 17 receive refunds.
- 18 <u>(d) The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs shall</u>
- 19 report annually to the respective committees of the Senate and
- 20 the House of Representatives which have jurisdiction over
- 21 military and veterans affairs on the amount received via the
- 22 <u>checkoff plan and how the funds were utilized.</u>
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
