AN ACT

Amending Title 15 (Corporations and Unincorporated Associations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general 2 provisions, providing for eligibility for receipt of State 3 4 resources. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 15 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 9 § 1111. Eligibility for receipt of State resources. 10 (a) Conditions. -- A domestic business corporation or a 11 foreign business corporation with 200 or more employees in this 12 Commonwealth shall not be eligible for a State contract, State 13 funding or a State grant if the corporation: 14 (1) has violated the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 15 (52 Stat. 1060, 29 U.S.C. § 201 et seq.) within the previous 16 five years;

(2) is found quilty of an unfair labor practice in this

- 1 <u>Commonwealth within the previous five years;</u>
- 2 (3) has violated the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987,
- 3 No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act,
- 4 <u>within the previous five years; or</u>
- 5 (4) fails to submit to the Department of State current
- 6 <u>bylaws of the corporation, which must provide for a</u>
- 7 <u>corporation having a governing board, that at least 20% of</u>
- 8 the members of the governing board of the corporation are
- 9 <u>current employees of the corporation and are elected by the</u>
- 10 <u>employees of the corporation.</u>
- 11 (b) Applicability. -- This section shall not apply if the
- 12 <u>condition described in subsection (a)(1), (2) or (3) occurred</u>
- 13 prior to the effective date of this section.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall apply to the following:
- 15 (1) A State contract entered into or renewed on or after
- 16 the effective date of this act.
- 17 (2) State funding approved or otherwise made on or after
- 18 the effective date of this act.
- 19 (3) A State grant approved on or after the effective
- 20 date of this act.
- 21 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
