8	Section 1. Section 405.3 of the act of June 13, 1967
9	(P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is amended by
10	adding a subsection to read:
11	Section 405.3. Responsibilities and Obligations of
12	Department, Applicants and Recipients* * *
13	(b) Subject to Federal approval, an authorized
14	representative designated by a person who is required to sign an
15	application for assistance shall sign an agreement with the
16	department indicating that the person understands and agrees to
17	be bound by the terms, conditions and responsibilities of the
18	electronic benefits transfer card, including the proper use of
19	the electronic benefits transfer card for the benefit of the

- 1 person who designated the authorized representative. If the
- 2 person fails to comply with the terms, conditions and
- 3 responsibilities of the electronic benefits transfer card, the
- 4 person designated as an authorized representative may not be
- 5 <u>designated as an authorized representative for any assistance</u>
- 6 program administered by the department.

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
