AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study,
- 6 providing for extended school year services.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1501.9. Extended School Year Services.--(a) Each
- 13 <u>student with an IEP shall be deemed eliqible for extended school</u>
- 14 year services during the summer of 2020. The following shall
- 15 apply:
- (1) Each school district shall notify, as appropriate,
- 17 parents and students of the right to participate in extended
- 18 <u>school year services and shall provide information as to the</u>
- 19 instructional options available.

- 1 (2) Nothing in this section shall be construed to equate
- 2 <u>extended school year services to compensatory education.</u>
- 3 (b) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 4 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 5 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 6 <u>"Compensatory education."</u> Supplementary programs or services
- 7 <u>designed for students when a school district does not provide a</u>
- 8 free and appropriate public education for students.
- 9 "Extended school year services." As defined in 34 CFR
- 10 300.106(b) (relating to extended school year services).
- "IEP." An individualized education program as established in
- 12 accordance with 22 Pa. Code § 14.131 (relating to IEP).
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
