AN ACT

- 1 Providing for an extension of preauthorization for health care
- service during disaster emergencies and for enforcement by
- 3 the Insurance Department.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Disaster
- 8 Emergency Health Insurance Preauthorization Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Health care provider." A hospital, health care facility or
- 14 person that is licensed, certified or otherwise authorized by
- 15 the laws of this Commonwealth to provide health care in the
- 16 ordinary course of business or practice of a profession.
- 17 "Health care service." A covered elective and nonurgent
- 18 admission or procedure provided, or proposed to be provided, by
- 19 a health care provider to an individual covered under a health

- 1 insurance policy. The term does not include a pharmaceutical
- 2 benefit.
- 3 "Health insurance policy." An individual or group health
- 4 insurance policy, contract or plan that provides coverage for
- 5 services provided by a health care facility or health care
- 6 provider that is offered by a health insurer. The term does not
- 7 include:
- 8 (1) Accident only.
- 9 (2) Fixed indemnity.
- 10 (3) Limited benefit.
- 11 (4) Credit only.
- 12 (5) Specified disease.
- 13 (6) Medicare supplement.
- 14 (7) Civilian Health and Medical Program of the Uniformed
- 15 Services (CHAMPUS) supplement.
- 16 (8) Long-term care or disability income.
- 17 (9) Workers' compensation.
- 18 (10) Automobile medical payment insurance.
- 19 "Health insurer." An entity that holds a valid license by
- 20 the Insurance Department with accident and health authority to
- 21 issue a health insurance policy and governed under any of the
- 22 following:
- 23 (1) The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as
- 24 The Insurance Company Law of 1921.
- 25 (2) The act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701, No.364),
- 26 known as the Health Maintenance Organization Act.
- 27 (3) 40 Pa.C.S. Chs. 61 (relating to hospital plan
- corporations) and 63 (relating to professional health
- 29 services plan corporations).
- 30 "Preauthorization." A review by a health insurer, or an

- 1 entity acting on behalf of a health insurer, of all reasonably
- 2 necessary supporting information and documentation that occurs
- 3 prior to the delivery of a health care service and results in a
- 4 decision to approve or deny payment for the health care service.
- 5 Section 3. Extension of preauthorization during disaster
- 6 emergencies.
- 7 A preauthorization for a health care service both approved
- 8 prior to and in effect on the date of a declaration by the
- 9 Governor of disaster emergency under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c)
- 10 (relating to general authority of Governor) shall remain
- 11 approved during the disaster emergency and for not less than 90
- 12 days from the date the disaster emergency terminates or expires
- 13 under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c), subject to the terms and conditions
- 14 of a health insurance policy.
- 15 Section 4. Enforcement.
- 16 (a) Duty of department.--The Insurance Department shall
- 17 enforce the provisions of this act.
- 18 (b) Violation.--A violation of this act shall be deemed a
- 19 violation of Article VI of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682,
- 20 No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921.
- 21 Section 5. Applicability.
- This act shall apply only to a health insurance policy in
- 23 effect during:
- 24 (1) The proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the
- Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March
- 26 21, 2020), and any renewal of the state of disaster
- emergency.
- 28 (2) Any other declaration of disaster emergency issued
- 29 by the Governor due to virus, bacterium or other
- microorganism under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to general

- 1 authority of Governor) after the effective date of this
- 2 section.
- 3 Section 6. Effective date.
- 4 This act shall take effect immediately.
