A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of May 2019 as "Blue Star Mothers of America Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc., was founded as a
- 4 patriotic service organization on February 1, 1942, to unite
- 5 mothers who had sons or daughters in the United States Armed
- 6 Forces; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The nonpartisan, nonsectarian, nondiscriminatory and
- 8 nonprofit organization was chartered by the Congress of the
- 9 United States in 1960; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mothers, stepmothers, grandmothers, foster mothers
- 11 and female legal guardians who have sons or daughters who are
- 12 currently serving in the United States military or who are
- 13 honorably discharged veterans are eligible for membership in the

- 1 organization; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Family members and friends may become associate
- 3 members, and fathers of military personnel or veterans may join
- 4 the Blue Star Dads' association; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The work of Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc.,
- 6 includes providing support for active duty service personnel and
- 7 families, promoting patriotism and assisting various veterans
- 8 organizations, including the American Gold Star Mothers, Inc.;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, The work of Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc., is
- 11 increasingly important because of:
- 12 (1) the hundreds of thousands of United States Armed
- Forces men and women who have served or are serving in
- 14 Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Iraqi Freedom and the
- 15 Global War on Terrorism; and
- 16 (2) the ongoing deployments of the Pennsylvania National
- Guard and our active duty military and its reserve
- 18 components;
- 19 and
- 20 WHEREAS, The dedication, sacrifice and hard work of the
- 21 devoted members of Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc., merit
- 22 recognition; and
- 23 WHEREAS, The Service flag, also known as the Blue Star Flag,
- 24 is an official banner authorized by the Department of Defense to
- 25 be displayed by families who have members serving in the United
- 26 States Armed Forces during a period of war or hostility in the
- 27 nation; and
- 28 WHEREAS, In 1917, the Blue Star Flag was designed and
- 29 patented by World War I Army Captain Robert L. Queisser of the
- 30 5th Ohio Infantry who had two sons serving on the front lines;

- 2 WHEREAS, The Blue Star Flag quickly became an unofficial
- 3 symbol used to represent a child in service; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 5 month of May 2019 as "Blue Star Mothers of America Month" in
- 6 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
- 8 residents of this Commonwealth to take some time during the
- 9 month of May 2019 to honor and recognize the dedication and
- 10 sacrifice of Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc.; and be it
- 11 further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize and
- 13 celebrate the history and contributions of Blue Star Mothers of
- 14 America, Inc.; and be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
