A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of May 10 through 16, 2020, as "National  
2 Women's Lung Health Week" in Pennsylvania and encouraging all  
3 residents of this Commonwealth to learn more about the  
4 detection and treatment of lung cancer.

5 WHEREAS, Every five minutes a woman in the United States  
6 learns that she has lung cancer; and

7 WHEREAS, While the lung cancer death rate among men has  
8 decreased 36% in the last 42 years, it has increased 84% among  
9 women; and

10 WHEREAS, Lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer deaths  
11 among women and men in the United States; and

12 WHEREAS, Lung cancer must be a national priority due to it  
13 having the lowest survival rate among cancers, representing more  
14 than one in five female cancer deaths in 2020; and

15 WHEREAS, The American Lung Association's LUNG FORCE  
16 initiative seeks to defeat lung cancer; therefore be it

17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
