A RESOLUTION

1 Petitioning the Governor to call a special session of the
2 General Assembly to address police accountability and police
3 violence.

4 WHEREAS, The nation has been shaken by police violence,
5 particularly directed against African Americans and people of
6 color; and

7 WHEREAS, The accountability for this police violence has been
8 minimal; and

9 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is not immune from this violence
10 and lack of accountability; and

11 WHEREAS, It is necessary to focus governmental attention upon
12 legislation to address police violence and police
13 accountability; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives petition the
15 Governor to call a special session of the General Assembly to
16 address police violence, particularly against African Americans
17 and people of color, and police accountability for such

1 violence; and be it further

2 RESOLVED, That this resolution be transmitted to the

3 Governor.
