## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing September 30, 2020, as "NICU Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Every year, more than 500,000 newborn babies are
- 4 admitted to the neonatal intensive care unit, also known as the
- 5 NICU; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The NICU is for babies who need intensive medical
- 7 care for complications related to preterm delivery, low birth
- 8 weight and health conditions that require special care; and
- 9 WHEREAS, NICUs have the advanced technology and trained
- 10 health care professionals needed to care for the smallest and
- 11 most fragile patients; and
- 12 WHEREAS, These highly specialized units treat newborns for a
- 13 variety of complications, including birth anomalies, brain
- 14 injury, cardiac conditions, infection, jaundice, neonatal
- 15 abstinence syndrome and respiratory distress; and
- 16 WHEREAS, NICU babies often experience complications that

- 1 persist beyond their stay in the hospital and may require
- 2 assistance with health and special needs throughout their
- 3 lifetimes; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Advances in neonatal medicine have allowed more
- 5 infants to benefit from the specialized care offered by NICUs;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, Funding for research into the causes of a NICU stay
- 8 and the holistic care of NICU families continues to be vital;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, Many families of NICU babies struggle to find the
- 11 education, resources and support they need; and
- 12 WHEREAS, "NICU Awareness Day" provides an opportunity for
- 13 families whose lives have been affected by the NICU to share
- 14 their stories, engage with the larger NICU community and honor
- 15 the dedicated health professionals who continue to advance the
- 16 important work of these units; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize
- 18 September 30, 2020, as "NICU Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
