AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," in school health services, providing
6 for parent educational information regarding eating
7 disorders.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
12 section to read:

13 Section 1425. Parent Educational Information Regarding
14 Eating Disorders.--(a) Each school entity shall annually
15 provide parent educational information regarding eating
16 disorders for pupils in grades five through twelve. The
17 information shall be consistent with guidelines established by
18 the Department of Education under subsection (b).

19 (b) The Department of Education, in conjunction with the
20 Department of Health, shall develop and implement guidelines for

1 providing parent educational information regarding eating
2 disorders. The policies shall be developed with input from
3 organizations and entities, including boards of school
4 directors, school superintendents, the National Eating Disorders
5 Association, the Pennsylvania Association of School Nurses and
6 Practitioners, the Pennsylvania Chapter of the American Academy
7 of Pediatrics, the Pennsylvania Academy of Family Physicians,
8 the International Association of Eating Disorders Professionals
9 Foundation and the Academy for Eating Disorders. In doing so,
10 the Department of Education and the Department of Health shall
11 identify and develop appropriate additions or revisions to this
12 Commonwealth's school health regulations related to development
13 of parent educational information, including guidance regarding
14 the clear delineation of such health information from other
15 administrative documentation. The guidelines developed under
16 this section shall include the following:

17 (1) The optional development of an eating disorder screening
18 program.

19 (2) Specification of training needs and requirements for
20 personnel and volunteers.

21 (3) Appropriate opt-out and exemption procedures.

22 (4) Parental notification procedures for positive
23 indications of an eating disorder.

24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
