4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:

18 § 3501. Definitions.

- 1 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 2 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 3 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 4 "Commonwealth agency." A department, agency or commission of
- 5 the Commonwealth under the policy supervision and control of the
- 6 Governor.
- 7 "Contractor." A person, including, but not limited to, a
- 8 bidder, offeror, loan recipient grantee or lessor, who has
- 9 furnished or performed or seeks to furnish or perform goods,
- 10 supplies, services, leased space, construction or other activity
- 11 with an executive agency.
- 12 "Department." The Treasury Department of the Commonwealth.
- 13 "Entity." A corporation, joint-stock association, business
- 14 trust, limited liability company, sole proprietorship, nonprofit
- 15 <u>corporation or Subchapter S corporation.</u>
- 16 "Improper payment." A payment made by a Commonwealth agency
- 17 that:
- 18 (1) exceeds the amount a recipient should have received
- 19 from a Commonwealth agency;
- 20 (2) is less than the amount a recipient should have
- 21 received from the Commonwealth;
- 22 (3) makes a payment to a recipient that was ineligible
- 23 <u>to receive money from the particular program from the</u>
- 24 Commonwealth;
- 25 (4) was ineligible;
- 26 (5) was duplicative or redundant;
- 27 (6) was for a service which was never received; or
- 28 (7) was for a service that does not account for or was
- 29 not given any of the available credits or the discounts
- 30 available for the service rendered.

- 1 "Initiative." The Do-Not-Pay Initiative established under
- 2 <u>section 3502</u> (relating to establishment).
- 3 "Office." The Governor's Budget Office.
- 4 "Payment." Money expended by the Commonwealth as part of the
- 5 operating budget for the Commonwealth.
- 6 "Recipient." An individual, contractor or entity.
- 7 <u>"Secretary." The Secretary of the Budget of the</u>
- 8 Commonwealth.
- 9 § 3502. Establishment.
- 10 (a) Initiative establishment. -- The Do-Not-Pay Initiative is
- 11 <u>established in the department for the purpose of monitoring</u>
- 12 <u>improper payments across Commonwealth agencies</u>. As part of the
- 13 <u>initiative</u>, the department shall enter into a memorandum of
- 14 understanding with the United States Treasury Department to join
- 15 the United States Treasury Department's Do Not Pay program.
- 16 (b) Operation and assistance. -- The office shall assist the
- 17 department in the operation of the initiative and ensure the
- 18 department has the necessary information from each Commonwealth
- 19 agency.
- 20 (c) Database. -- The initiative shall provide a searchable
- 21 database of recipients that are not eliqible to receive payment
- 22 from the Commonwealth under section 3503 (relating to award and
- 23 <u>payment</u>).
- 24 (d) Agency use of database. -- An agency shall, with the
- 25 assistance of the office, utilize the database under subsection
- 26 (c) in order to determine eligibility for the awarding and
- 27 <u>disbursement of payments.</u>
- 28 (e) Information sharing. -- A Commonwealth agency shall
- 29 provide the department with all information necessary for the
- 30 operation and maintenance of the initiative.

- 1 (f) Prohibition. -- A Commonwealth agency may not award or
- 2 issue payment to a recipient that is listed on the initiative's
- 3 database unless the payment is determined by the secretary of
- 4 the agency as being necessary and:
- 5 (1) The award or payment is for services which cannot be
- 6 provided or provided in a timely manner by another entity or
- 7 <u>recipient.</u>
- 8 (2) The award or payment is required as a condition of
- 9 <u>receiving Federal money for programs jointly funded with</u>
- 10 Federal and Commonwealth money.
- 11 § 3503. Award and payment.
- 12 (a) Procedural review.--A Commonwealth agency shall review
- 13 procedures regarding the awarding and payment of money prior to
- 14 the awarding or releasing of any payment to verify and determine
- 15 <u>eligibility of a recipient for payment or award.</u>
- 16 (b) Database review. -- In order to verify eligibility under
- 17 this section for an award or payment, a Commonwealth agency must
- 18 utilize the following databases:
- 19 (1) Death certificates maintained by the Division of
- Vital Records of the Department of Health.
- 21 (2) The Death Master File of the Social Security
- 22 Administration.
- 23 (3) The Debarment and Suspension List of the Department
- of General Services.
- 25 (4) The Credit Alert System or Credit Alert Interactive
- Voice Response System under the United States Department of
- 27 Housing and Urban Development.
- 28 (5) The list of excluded individuals and entities under
- the Department of Human Services Medicheck List.
- 30 (6) The list of individuals or entities under the

- 1 Department of Revenue who are delinquent in payments owed to
- 2 the Commonwealth.
- 3 (7) The central registry under 23 Pa.C.S. § 4376
- 4 <u>(relating to central registry).</u>
- 5 (8) Databases used by the Federal Government for the
- 6 <u>initiative administered by the United States Department of</u>
- 7 <u>the Treasury.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 365 days.
