11	(1) "Racketeering activity" means all of the following:
12	(i) An act which is indictable under any of the
13	following provisions of this title:

15	Section 2706 (relating to terroristic threats)
16	Chapter 29 (relating to kidnapping)
17	Chapter 30 (relating to human trafficking)

- 1 (iv) The collection of any money or other property
 2 in full or partial satisfaction of a debt which arose as
 3 the result of the lending of money or other property at a
 4 rate of interest exceeding 25% per annum or the
 5 equivalent rate for a longer or shorter period, where not
 6 otherwise authorized by law.
- 7 (v) An offense indictable under 4 Pa.C.S. Pt. II 8 (relating to gaming).

An act which otherwise would be considered racketeering
activity by reason of the application of this paragraph,
shall not be excluded from its application solely because the
operative acts took place outside the jurisdiction of this
Commonwealth, if such acts would have been in violation of
the law of the jurisdiction in which they occurred.
