(xv) (xvi) Military Officers Association of America. 17 18 (xvii) The Korean War Veterans Association, Inc. 19 (xviii) The Navy Club of the United States of 20 America. 21 Four members at large appointed by the Governor from (3) a list provided by the Adjutant General, each of whom shall 22 23 be a veteran and a member in good and regular standing of a 24 Pennsylvania branch, post, lodge or club of a recognized 25 national veterans' organization active in this Commonwealth. 26 At least one member shall be a female veteran, and at least 27 one member shall be a veteran of the Vietnam era. Members at 28 large shall serve a term of four years and until a successor 29 has been appointed.
