- 12 § 5751. Social distancing and capacity.
- 13 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 14 law, the social distancing requirement within a minor league
- baseball stadium shall be three feet during the COVID-19 15
- 16 disaster emergency.
- (b) Exceptions. -- The following shall apply: 17

- 1 (1) Individuals purchasing tickets together and
- 2 <u>attending as a group shall not be subject to the social</u>
- distancing requirement under subsection (a) with members of
- 4 <u>their group.</u>
- 5 (2) A minor league baseball team may, at the team's sole
- discretion, impose a social distancing requirement higher
- 7 than the requirement under subsection (a) as the team deems
- 8 <u>necessary.</u>
- 9 (c) Maximum capacity. -- Neither the Commonwealth nor any
- 10 municipality may restrict the maximum capacity of a minor league
- 11 baseball stadium to a number lower than 50% during the COVID-19
- 12 <u>disaster emergency.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
