- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 8
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- Section 1314-B. Limitation on masking order. 12
- 13 (a) Limitation. -- Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
- contrary, beginning on the effective date of this section, 14
- 15 students and staff of a school entity and nonpublic school shall
- 16 not be subject to the masking order and may not be required to
- 17 wear a mask or universal face covering at school.
- 18 (b) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this 19

- 1 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 2 "Masking order." The updated order of the Secretary of the
- 3 Pennsylvania Department of Health Requiring Universal Face
- 4 Coverings issued on November 17, 2020, and any renewal of the
- 5 order, and any new order to prevent the spread of a communicable
- 6 <u>disease.</u>
- 7 "Nonpublic school." A nonprofit school, other than a public
- 8 <u>school</u>, within this Commonwealth wherein a resident of this
- 9 <u>Commonwealth may legally fulfill the compulsory school</u>
- 10 attendance requirements of this act which meet the requirements
- 11 of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Public Law 88-352,
- 12 <u>78 Stat. 241).</u>
- 13 "School entity." A public school, including a charter school
- 14 or cyber charter school, private school, intermediate unit or
- 15 area career and technical school operating within this
- 16 Commonwealth.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
