## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 20, 1979 (P.L.183, No.60), entitled "An
- act regulating the terms and conditions of certain leases
- regarding natural gas and oil," further providing for
- 4 definitions.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 1.2 of the act of July 20, 1979 (P.L.183,
- 8 No.60), known as the Oil and Gas Lease Act, is amended by adding
- 9 a definition to read:
- 10 Section 1.2. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 \* \* \*
- 15 "Royalty." The lessor's ownership interest in the gross
- 16 proceeds generated at the first arm's-length point of sale of
- 17 oil, natural gas or gas of other designations to a third-party

- 1 purchaser unaffiliated with the lessee or, to the extent the
- 2 <u>underlying lease allows the lessor to take the lessor's royalty</u>
- 3 in kind, the lessor's ownership interest in the oil, natural gas
- 4 or gas of other designations at the same location, but from
- 5 which ownership interest is excluded the costs of development
- 6 and drilling and all postproduction expenses directly or
- 7 indirectly incurred or paid by the lessee between the wellhead
- 8 and the point of sale.
- 9 Section 2. The addition of the definition of "royalty" in
- 10 section 1.2 of the act shall apply to oil, natural gas or gas
- 11 produced after the effective date of this section.
- 12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
