AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 5 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and 17 prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 18 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 19 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 20 determined," in judicial administration, providing for 21 22 judicial facilities. - 25 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 26 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a
- 27 section to read:

- 1 Section 2803-E. Judicial facilities.
- 2 (a) Operations. --- No later than 60 days after the effective
- 3 date of this section, the administrative office shall transfer
- 4 the operations of the Supreme Court, Commonwealth Court and
- 5 Superior Court to the Pennsylvania Judicial Center in the City
- 6 <u>of Harrisburg.</u>
- 7 (b) Duties.--In order to facilitate the transfer under
- 8 <u>subsection (a), the administrative office shall have the</u>
- 9 <u>following duties:</u>
- 10 (1) Terminate any lease used for the operations of the
- of the Supreme Court, Commonwealth Court and Superior Court
- 12 <u>outside the City of Harrisburg.</u>
- 13 (2) Sell any building owned by the administrative office
- and used for the operations of the Supreme Court,
- 15 Commonwealth Court and Superior Court outside the City of
- 16 Harrisburg.
- 17 (3) Take any other action necessary to facilitate the
- 18 transfer under subsection (a).
- 19 (c) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term
- 20 "administrative office" means the Administrative Office of
- 21 Pennsylvania Courts under 42 Pa.C.S. § 1902 (relating to
- 22 Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts).
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
