13	(b) Staffing requirements
14	(1) Except as provided under paragraph (2) <u>or (5)</u> <
15	SUBSECTION (C)(1), minimum staffing for a BLS ambulance when <
16	responding to a call to provide EMS is an ambulance

1 attendant, EMR or EMT, a second EMS provider at or above the 2 EMT level and an EMS vehicle operator, except that only the 3 two EMS providers need to respond if one of them is also the 4 EMS vehicle operator. When present, an EMS provider above the 5 EMR level must attend to the patient at the scene and during 6 patient transportation.

- 8 (5) The minimum staffing requirements for a BLS <---9 ambulance in a county of the fifth, sixth, seventh or eighth 10 class when responding to a call to provide EMS is an EMS 11 vehicle operator and an EMS provider at or above the level of 12 an EMT. When present, an EMS provider at or above the level 13 of an EMT shall attend to the patient at the scene and <u>durina</u> 14 patient transportation.

- 16 (C) EXCEPTIONS.--

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[THE STAFFING REQUIREMENTS UNDER SUBSECTION (B) (2) 17 (1)18 MAY BE WAIVED OR ADJUSTED AT THE DEPARTMENT'S DISCRETION. THE 19 DEPARTMENT SHALL PERMIT AN EMS AGENCY TO FILE FOR A WAIVER OR 20 EXCEPTION FROM THE STAFFING REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS 21 SUBSECTION FOR EXTRAORDINARY REASONS AS DETERMINED BY THE 22 DEPARTMENT ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS AND IN THE BEST INTEREST 23 OF THE EMS SYSTEM AND PATIENT CARE.] THE MINIMUM STAFFING 24 REQUIREMENTS FOR A BLS AMBULANCE WHEN RESPONDING TO A CALL TO PROVIDE EMS IS AN EMS VEHICLE OPERATOR AND AN EMS PROVIDER AT 25 26 OR ABOVE THE LEVEL OF AN EMT. WHEN PRESENT, AN EMS PROVIDER AT OR ABOVE THE LEVEL OF AN EMT SHALL ATTEND TO THE PATIENT 27 28 AT THE SCENE AND DURING PATIENT TRANSPORTATION. * * * 29
