Amending Titles 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in 2 sentencing, further providing for sentence of total 3 confinement; and, in licensing of drivers, further providing 4 for driving while operating privilege is suspended or 5 revoked. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 9756 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania 10 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 11 § 9756. Sentence of total confinement. 12 * * * (c.2) <u>Determinate sentence.--The court may impose a</u> 13 14 determinate sentence for a violation under 75 Pa.C.S. (relating 15 to vehicles) when a summary offense is charged and the maximum 16 sentence of total confinement imposed is 90 days or less. 17 * * * 18 Section 2. Section 1543(b)(1)(i) and (ii) and (1.1)(i) of 19 Title 75 are amended to read:

§ 1543. Driving while operating privilege is suspended or

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3 (b) Certain offenses.--

(1) The following shall apply:

- A person who drives a motor vehicle on a highway (i) or trafficway of this Commonwealth at a time when the person's operating privilege is suspended or revoked as a condition of acceptance of Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition for a violation of section 3802 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance) or the former section 3731, because of a violation of section 1547(b)(1) (relating to suspension for refusal) or 3802 or former section 3731 or is suspended under section 1581 (relating to Driver's License Compact) for an offense substantially similar to a violation of section 3802 or former section 3731 shall, upon a first conviction, be guilty of a summary offense and shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$500 and to undergo imprisonment for [a period of not less than] 60 days [nor more than 90 days].
- (ii) A second violation of this paragraph shall constitute a summary offense and, upon conviction of this paragraph, a person shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$1,000 and to undergo imprisonment for [not less than] 90 days.

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(1.1) (i) A person who has an amount of alcohol by weight in his blood that is equal to or greater than .02% at the time of testing or who at the time of testing has in his blood any amount of a Schedule I or nonprescribed

1 Schedule II or III controlled substance, as defined in the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The 2 3 Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, or its metabolite or who refuses testing of blood or breath 4 5 and who drives a motor vehicle on any highway or trafficway of this Commonwealth at a time when the 6 7 person's operating privilege is suspended or revoked as a 8 condition of acceptance of Accelerated Rehabilitative 9 Disposition for a violation of section 3802 or former section 3731 or because of a violation of section 1547(b) 10 (1) or 3802 or former section 3731 or is suspended under 11 12 section 1581 for an offense substantially similar to a 13 violation of section 3802 or former section 3731 shall, 14 upon a first conviction, be guilty of a summary offense 15 and shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$1,000 and to undergo imprisonment for [a period of not less than] 90 16 17 days.

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19 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
