## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in sexual offenses, further providing
- for the offense of sexual extortion.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3133(e) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3133. Sexual extortion.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (e) Sentencing. -- The Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing,
- 11 in accordance with 42 Pa.C.S. § 2154 (relating to adoption of
- 12 guidelines for sentencing), shall provide for a sentence
- 13 enhancement within its guidelines for an offense under this
- 14 section when:
- 15 <u>(1)</u> at the time of the offense the complainant is under
- 16 18 years of age or has an intellectual disability or the
- 17 actor holds a position of trust or supervisory or

- disciplinary power over the complainant by virtue of the
- 2 actor's legal, professional or occupational status[.]; or
- 3 (2) the complainant attempts suicide resulting in
- 4 <u>serious bodily injury or dies by suicide, within 90 days of</u>
- 5 the commission of the offense, as a proximate result of the
- 6 trauma that the complainant experienced during or following
- 7 the commission of the offense.

- 9 Section 2. The addition of 18 Pa.C.S. § 3133(e)(2) shall
- 10 apply to offenses committed on or after the effective date of
- 11 this section.
- 12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
