AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in traffic-control devices, further providing for  
3 traffic-control signals.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3112(a)(3) of Title 75 of the  
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a  
8 subparagraph to read:

9 § 3112. Traffic-control signals.

10 (a) General rule.--Whenever traffic is controlled by  
11 traffic-control signals exhibiting different colored lights, or  
12 colored lighted arrows, successively one at a time or in  
13 combination, only the colors green, red and yellow shall be  
14 used, except for special pedestrian signals carrying a word  
15 legend, and the lights shall indicate and apply to drivers of  
16 vehicles and pedestrians as follows:

18 (3) Steady red indication.--

2                   (ii.1) Turning at a steady red signal under  
3                   subparagraph (ii) is prohibited at intersections within  
4                   or adjacent to a school zone during the school zone hours  
5                   of operation. The department shall post signage to  
6                   indicate the prohibition of turns under this subparagraph  
7                   at all traffic-control signals within and adjacent to  
8                   school zones.

10                  Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
