AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 7 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 12 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 17 18 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 19 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 20 determined," in powers and duties of the Department of 21 General Services and its departmental administrative and 22 23 advisory boards and commissions, further providing for transfer authority over Lieutenant Governor's Mansion. 24 25 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 26 hereby enacts as follows: 27 Section 1. Section 2402.3(b) of the act of April 9, 1929 28 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is

- 7 Mansion but shall AND provide equivalent facilities space for <--

- 9 National Guard to include current and survivor families as part
- 10 of the facilities master plan.

- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
