## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, " in reimbursements by Commonwealth and
- 6 between school districts, providing for level-up supplemental
- 7 basic education funding for the 2021-2022 school year.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 12 section to read:
- 13 Section 2502.55. Level-up Supplemental Basic Education
- 14 Funding for the 2021-2022 School Year. -- (a) From money
- 15 appropriated for payment of basic education funding to school
- 16 <u>districts in the 2022-2023 fiscal year, the Commonwealth shall</u>
- 17 pay to qualifying school districts an allocation for the 2021-
- 18 2022 school year payable in the 2022-2023 fiscal year as

- 1 <u>follows:</u>
- 2 (1) There shall be a determination of the qualifying school
- 3 <u>districts with an amount less than or equal to the amount that</u>
- 4 represents the twentieth percentile for all school districts in
- 5 the following calculation:
- 6 (i) For each of the five preceding school years, calculate
- 7 the following:
- 8 (A) For each school district, the sum of the amount of
- 9 student weights calculated under section 2502.53(c)(1)(ii),
- 10 (iii), (iv), (v) and (vi), and the amount of weighted special
- 11 education headcounts calculated under section 2509.5(bbb)(2)(i).
- 12 (B) For each school district, divide the current
- 13 <u>expenditures by the sum calculated for the school district in</u>
- 14 clause (A).
- 15 (C) For each school district, calculate the average of the
- 16 quotients calculated under clause (B).
- 17 (2) Qualifying school districts determined under paragraph
- 18 (1) shall receive an amount calculated as follows:
- 19 (i) For each qualifying school district, multiply the
- 20 product in section 2502.53(b)(2)(i) for the 2021-2022 school
- 21 year by three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000).
- 22 (ii) Divide the product in subparagraph (i) by the sum of
- 23 the products in section 2502.53(b)(2)(i) for the 2021-2022
- 24 school year for all qualifying school districts.
- 25 (b) Payments made under this section shall be deemed to be
- 26 part of the school district's allocation amount under section
- 27 <u>2502.53(b)(1) for the 2022-2023 school year and each school year</u>
- 28 thereafter.
- 29 (c) The provisions contained in sections 2502.53 and 2509.5
- 30 shall apply to the calculation of the respective factors in this

- 1 <u>section.</u>
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
