Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in penalties and disposition of fines, further 2 providing for subsequent convictions of certain offenses. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 6503(a) and (a.1) of Title 75 of the 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 7 § 6503. Subsequent convictions of certain offenses. 8 9 General offenses. -- Every person convicted of a second or subsequent violation of any of the following provisions shall be 10 11 sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than 12 \$1,000 or to imprisonment for not more than six months, or both: 13 Section 1543(a) (relating to driving while operating 14 privilege is suspended or revoked) except as set forth in 15 subsection (a.1). 16 Section 3367 (relating to racing on highways). Section 3713 (relating to railroad trains not to block 17

- 4 (a.1) Certain repeat offenses. -- A person convicted of a
- 5 sixth or subsequent offense under section 1543(a) or 3713 shall
- 6 be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$1,000 and to
- 7 imprisonment for not less than 30 days but not more than six
